What questions will you need to answer to win a Fleet Safety Award?

Below are the main RoSPA Fleet Safety Awards entry questions that show you what you will need to answer in order to win a RoSPA Award. Each question has a word limit of 600 words and you can supply eight pieces of evidence, statistics and real-life examples. By providing this evidence it can help you achieve a higher award level.

- 1. Provide a brief organisation profile describing the structure of the organisation and its principal work activities including fleet relevant information e.g. number and type of fleet vehicles; number of company drivers and percentage of 'grey fleet' drivers and overall annual mileage for employees' work related driving.
- 2. How is driving risk and work-related road safety managed throughout your organisation?
- 3. How is driver competence managed within your fleet?
- 4. Detail your fleet and driver safety risk assessment policies.
- 5. Detail your approach to facilitating safe driving through management of task, behavioural, and environmental considerations.
- 6. Describe new or innovative approaches or control measures used to manage your occupational road risk, introduced or used during 2023.
- 7. Performance indicators including injury/vehicle collision data.
- 8. Demonstrate how you approach communicating road safety standards and driving risk information within your organisation and through your supply chain and affected communities.
- 9. Detail your arrangements for active monitoring of your fleet and driver safety performance and to check that your work-related road safety policies are being put into practice.
- 10. Investigation of accidents/problems and implementation of the lessons learned.
- 11. Review of performance against targets, setting new priorities reporting to stakeholders.
