

Driver Theory Workshop

► Course objectives

This workshop aims to ensure that all those who drive for work have an understanding of the principles of defensive driving.

Delegates should develop a positive attitude to driving and gain an understanding of how personal factors can affect performance.

► Who should attend?

All those who drive a car or light goods vehicle for work purposes.

► Course content
