

Vehicle Familiarisation

► Course objectives

The course aims to introduce and familiarise delegates to a new vehicle so that they can navigate themselves safely and with confidence.

By the end of this course delegates should:

- Have a good working knowledge of the new vehicle and its features
- Understand the vehicle's characteristics and limitations
- Understand and be aware of additional features, such as ABS, traction control, etc.
- Be aware of fuel type and requirements
- Have knowledge of auxiliary equipment, such as sat nav technology
- Have a location knowledge of emergency equipment, e.g. spare wheel, jack, wheel brace, etc.

► Who should attend?

Anyone who drives for work and needs to become familiar with a new vehicle.

► Additional information

It is advised that the delegate obtains an up-to-date copy of the Vehicle Handbook and Company Driver Handbook. It would be beneficial for the delegate to bring these on the day.

The course is available in a range of vehicle types.
