

NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety

► Course objectives

- To provide delegates with sufficient knowledge to be able to complete the written assessment at the end of the course and after further private study to successfully complete the NEBOSH written and practical assessments
- The course should provide an understanding of health and safety legislation to enable delegates to monitor safety performance in their workplace, investigate accidents effectively and assist in the design and implementation of safe systems of work and accident prevention programmes
- It will also provide an appreciation of hazards associated with typical workplace activities, enabling them to fulfil their occupational health and safety responsibilities
- To assist management of safety within the workplace

► Who should attend?

The course is designed for existing and newly-appointed safety officers, managers and others with responsibility for the management of safety within the workplace.

An awareness of health and safety issues would be an advantage but is not essential.

► Further information

The practical assessment must be completed in the workplace and submitted no later than two weeks after the NEBOSH exam. Please note that the NEBOSH exam must be booked in addition to the two-week course.
