

Abrasive Wheel Instructors

► Course objectives

To develop delegates' skill in training abrasive wheel operators according to the schedule of training of the abrasive wheel regulations.

On completion of this course, delegates should be able to instruct colleagues in the safe setting and use of abrasive wheels.

The course is intended for staff with responsibility for training others in the correct methods and techniques of setting and dressing abrasive wheels.

Delegates should have successfully completed RoSPA's **Abrasive Wheel Setters** course or be able to demonstrate competency, knowledge and understanding, which will adequately support training as an instructor.

An ability to instruct others is essential. Formal training in instructional techniques is preferred, e.g. ENB 998 (Teaching and Assessing); City & Guilds 7331.
