

A Safety Checklist for Parents

A major programme to promote awareness and prevent accidents with household cleaning products

Cleaning Products	Yes	No
Are all household cleaning products including liquid laundry capsules stored in a secure place out of the		
reach and sight of children?		
Wherever possible do you buy products in child-resistant or child-safety packaging?		
Do you ensure you never pierce or break liquid laundry capsules?		
Do you always store cleaning products in their original container?		
Do you store food and household products separately?		
Do you always read the label to find out how to use household products safely?		
Do you always close the lid of liquid laundry capsules and other household products securely and store out		
of reach and sight of children immediately after use?		
Do you know what to do if a household product is accidently ingested or spilt on the skin?		

Medicines	Yes	No
Are all medicines stored in a lockable cupboard out of the reach of children?		
Do you always store medicines in their original containers?		
Do you dispose of old medicines safely by returning them to the pharmacy?		
Do you know what to do if medicine is accidently ingested?		
Where ever possible do you buy products in child-resistant or child-safety packaging?		

Other Poisoning Risks	Yes	No
Do you ensure that gas appliances and heaters are checked and serviced regularly?		
Do you keep electronic cigarettes out of the reach of children?		
Do you keep button batteries out of the reach of children?		
Do you check plants to ensure that they are not poisonous or that they can irritate your skin?		
Are all garden and decorating products stored in a secure place out of the reach of children?
