Action on Accidents

RoSPA in association with the Royal College for Emergency Medicine calling for a £2 million per year nationwide programme in Scotland to reduce unintentional (accidental) injuries to under 5's. Such a programme would be effective in reducing harm to our children save costs and take pressure off Scotlish hospital Emergency Departments.

Launched in February 2016, RoSPA in Scotland establishing a team of ambassadors to assist in communicating core messages about the cost to business, families and the wider community of accidents. This builds on the Big Book of Accident Prevention and will develop a network of volunteers prepared to speak up on the accident prevention agenda.
