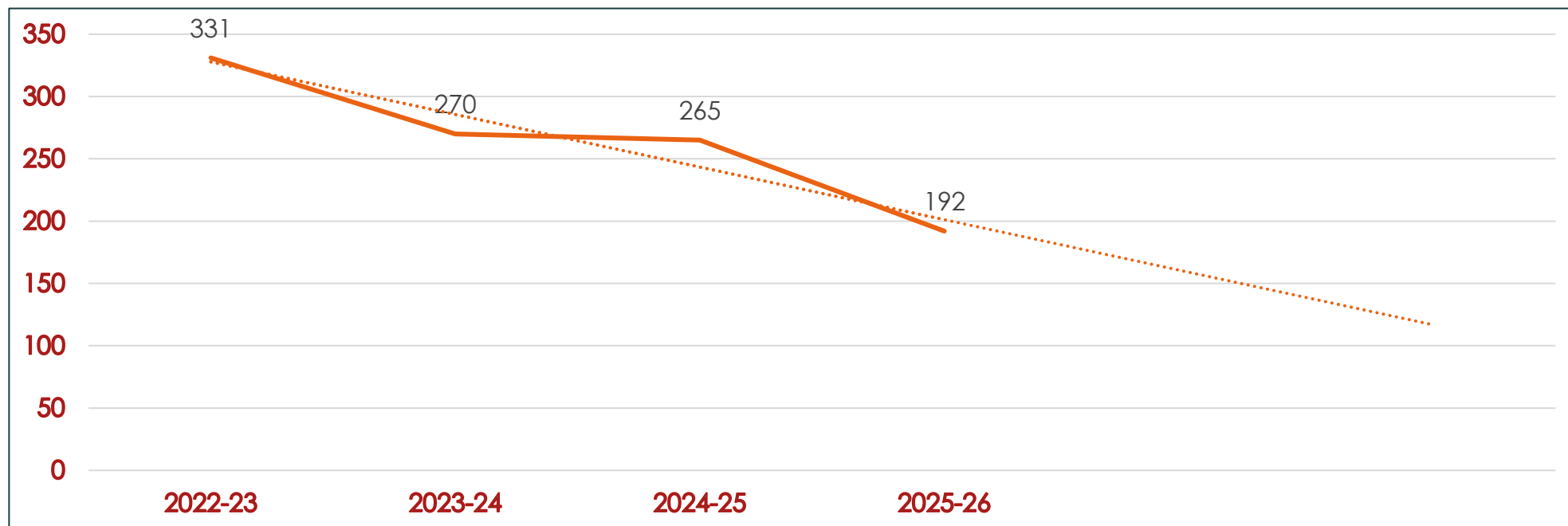
Fife Cares - child safety visits

- Cover the whole of Fife
- Regardless of tenancy
- Advice and information (verbal and written) provided
- Equipment Supplied where appropriate
- Been in existence since 1992

- Campaigns
 - Child Safety Week
 - Safer Toys for Christmas
- Referrals from Health Visitors, Family Nurse Partnership, Social Work etc.
